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What are Line & Wrinkle Treatments...?

Line & Wrinkle Treatments are commonly used to treat areas in the upper part of the face. Lines & wrinkles can be minimised by using a purified protein produced by Clostridium Botulinum bacteria which induces long term relaxation of contracted muscles.

Wrinkle relaxing injections have been used since the late 1980's to treat millions of patients worldwide and, with minimal risks and no recovery time, is now the world's most popular non-surgical treatment.

Why do we need them...?

Over time, as we naturally age, overactive muscle movement gradually wears away the collagen in our skin, causing the skin to crease and wrinkles to appear. Line & wrinkle treatments work only on the specific muscles injected, leaving surrounding muscles to function as usual, enabling normal facial expression, just with less wrinkles.

The dentists in this practice have been extensively trained to provide these treatments.

What can they be used for...?

The treatment, known as BOTOX[®], has been approved for cosmetic use under a new name - VISTABEL[®] - and is ideal for easing over-active muscle movement. The most popular areas to treat are:

- Frown lines between the eyes
- Forehead lines
- Crows feet



What is Restylane...?

Restylane is a long-lasting gel that, once injected into the skin with an ultra-fine needle, lifts and adds volume to the areas being treated. Similar to one of the body's own natural substances (hyaluronic acid) this is a completely safe product. The hyaluronic acid in Restylane simply supplements the body's own age-depleted hyaluronic acid to plump up the lips or to raise the skin and 'fill in' the particular wrinkle being treated.

What is Restylane used for...?

- Wrinkle correction
- Lip enhancement
- Smile lines - fine lines around the eyes, mouth etc...
- Deep folds
- Shaping facial contours - such as cheeks and chin
- Volume augmentation of the lips

Restylane is not suitable for deep wrinkles and certain types of acne scar.

How long does the treatment take?

Treatment time for Restylane is approx 30 minutes

How long will the treatment last...?

The effect of a Restylane treatment will vary from individual to individual. It very much depends on factors such as the person's age and lifestyle, the structure of the skin, and the degree of perfection required. Most patients choose to have a further treatment within a year since the hyaluronic acid, being a natural substance, dissolves over time.
